Show for 2020

I was reelected Show Chair at the June general meeting and 2020 Show planning has started. First order of business is to establish the 2020 Show Committee. Members have been contacted about serving. If you are not a 2019 Show Committee member but think that you would like to help with the show planning, please email me at gandpmaggard@gmail.com and let me know where your interests lie. Peggy and I are currently doing multiple jobs on the Show Committee and we would like to hand off some of these jobs to somebody else. Specifically, are the multiple jobs that we are doing:

Grab Bags – Plan and organize grab bag activities including getting grab bags sewn, getting specimens with labels prepared for bagging in specimen plastic bags, keeping track of what minerals/fossils/etc. that we need in order to fill grab bags with the 10 items that go in each bag, and plan and organize grab bag assembly work days. Ideally the Grab Bag Chair would have good Excel skills and a lot of free storage space.

Volunteer Coordinator – Prepare signup sheets for each club activity for members to sign up for working at the show and bring them to the Jan-March meetings for people to sign up. After the March meeting contact members to see if they would be willing to be signed up for work at the show, and where and when. Prepare a master work schedule for club activities. Prepare individual work schedules for every club member working at the show. Prepare activity work schedules for the Chair of each club activity. Distribute the schedules. At the show, check at each shift change to confirm that workers actually showed up to work as scheduled. Know who is available at the show to fill in any unscheduled vacancies.

Assistant Admissions Chair – Be available to work Admissions closely with Peggy with the idea to learn the job so that if for some reason Peggy would become unavailable the assistant could take over and run Admissions. This is not a hard job but the Admissions Chair must have a clear understanding of how Admissions works and is able to supervise and direct the workers to make sure that the Admissions activity is running correctly.

Assistant Show Chair – Be available to work with me throughout the year to learn and assist with the Show Chair job. The Assistant Show Chair must have good organizational and planning skills, good email and computer skills, be able to set and meet deadlines, work well with others, keep track of all the planning activities going on and that others on the committee are doing their jobs, and help organize and administer the Show. The Assistant Show Chair should be able to learn and understand the Show Chair job so that they can take over if the show Chair becomes unavailable.

There will be a mid to late July Show Committee meeting with two goals in mind: Review the vendor list and decide who we want to invite to be at the 2020 Show and set Junior Rock Pile/Grab Bag work dates in the September-November time frame. At least two workdays will need to be scheduled.


